Gordon J. Scott passed away on July 24, 2013. He was preceded in death by Sylvia P. Scott, his wife of 56 years, on November 3, 2009. Gordon was born on June 1, 1931 in Mashalltown, Iowa to Harry and Joyce Scott. First moving to Indianola and then to Grinnell, Iowa where he graduated from Grinnell High school as a "49er."

He obtained a job working on the railroad, which brought him to Arizona, where he met his lovely immigrant bride from England. They met on a church outing to the Granite Dells pool in Prescott as neither were interested in swimming. Gordon joined the Navy, however married Sylvia prior to his first deployment on May 24, 1953. One of his favorite conversations was about Sylvia joining him in Hawaii for a few weeks.
