Gregory T. Nordyke, 64, of Prescott passed away on August 16, 2015. Greg was born in Riverside, California to Robert and Virginia(Dolly) Nordyke. Greg attended high school at Yucca Valley High School and graduated in 1969, he then went on to College at Northern Arizona University and obtained a Bachelor of Science in Chemistry. He worked as a law enforcement officer with the City of Flagstaff for one year before moving to Prescott and worked the next 32 years with the City of Prescott Police department , retiring in 2008 as a Lieutenant.

Greg held the positions of patrol officer, detective, motor officer, Sergeant and Lieutenant. During his tenure as Sergeant and Lieutenant, his assignments included commands in Patrol, Investigations, Special Operations, Records, & Communication, Professional Standards, SWAT, Training, and the Department Honor Guard.

Prior to retirement Greg became a member of a National Incident Management Team as a Liaison Officer. Shortly after retirement he became a reserve firefighter for the Groom Creek Fire District and participated in local and off-district wildland fire assignments as a crew member. Greg volunteered as Liaison officer for the Arizona Wildland Fire and Incident Management Academy for eight sessions.

Greg is survived by his wife Sharon, mother Virginia (Dolly) Nordyke, daughter Autum Nordyke Trujillo, sons Todd and Jeff, grandchildren, Rylee, Millie, Clark, Jaina, Zachary Nordyke, Taylor Kruse, Danielle Trujillo, sister Shelley
