Jane Anne Langerak Meier was born November 18, 1940 in Des Moines, Iowa and passed away on November 25, 2014 in Prescott, Arizona at the age of 74. She worked as an elementary school teacher and Title 1 reading instructor in Monticello and Big Lake, Minnesota until her retirement in 1998.
