Lorna Dawn Street, age 78, of Casa Grande, Arizona died peacefully at home on January 25, 2022 while surrounded by her loving family. Born June 10, 1943 in Bay City, Michigan to John Stock and Bertha (Dewey) Stock, Lorna was the 4th of 5 children. Lorna was an intelligent, amazing, driven, can-do woman who saw every challenge in life as an opportunity to grow and improve the world around her. She faithfully served in public schools and in federal and county government most of her working life. She enjoyed assisting in undercover work with the FBI, Division of ATF, and the US Marshall, being “wired up” and catching the bad guys! She earned her private pilot’s license and was a member of the Ninety-Nines, having fun flying a Citabria. When she moved to Yavapai County she successfully campaigned to become the first female assessor in County history, a post she held for two terms. She then ran for the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors and proudly served for one term, helping to accomplish the Fain Road project. Lorna had a lifelong love of music and enjoyed her time in the Sweet Adelines, singing in and leading church choirs, and playing piano and organ. Her family has many fond memories of singing around the piano while she played hymns and standards. In 1972, she married Paul Street and they spent almost 50 years roaming the US and Canada in their RV. There was never a dull moment with Lorna, who was competitive and “told it like it was”. She enjoyed playing cards and computer games, working puzzles and crosswords, watching football and Jeopardy, camping, gardening, and being with her grandchildren. She was

devoted to her family and her faith. Lorna is survived by her husband Paul, (step) children Cindy Daniels of Chino Valley, AZ and Jeff (Tonda) Street of Lac-Beauport, Quebec, Canada, brother Walt Stock of Smithville, TN, nine grandchildren, and five great grandchildren. At her request, there will be no service. The family wishes to thank Savior Hospice and Hampton Funeral Home for their kindness and compassionate assistance.
