Nancy "Lora" Rowe, was born Sept. 28, 1925 in Wheeling, West Virginia to Ralph Norman Fisher and Mary Jane " Mollie"(Stine) Fisher.

The three of them moved to Arizona in 1930 to treat her fathers Tuberculosis. They lived "on the desert" until 1933, when they moved to Prescott. Ralph died in 1936. Lora married Mack Rowe in 1943. Two years later, while Mack was serving in the war, Mollie died. Lora worked for the Unemployment Office taking claims in Yavapai County for 28 years. She was a life time member of the Moose Lodge, Prescott Chapter. Mack and Lora were avid square dancers in their younger years.
