One of her hardest days was the passing of her son Clint from cancer at the age of 28, but she never allowed it to stop her from giving her love to her remaining children and showing what true strength, respect and love looked like. She loved to garden, and her yard was a spectacle come springtime. Passers by would stop, to comment on how beautiful her flowers were. She entered her dahlias into the county fair many times and won ribbons consistently. Her other great loves were her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. They were her pride and joy, and she showed them every day how much she loved them! She will always

be remembered for her strong faith in Jesus Christ and the unconditional love she had for all she met. Norma was preceded in death by her parents Art and Katherine, her sister Ethel and her oldest son Clint. She is survived by her daughters Lori (David), Tracy (Robert) and her son Mathew.
