



Richard A (Dick) Jacobs

Richard Allen Jacobs (Dick), a beloved husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather and pillar of the Prescott community, passed away on January 10, 2025 in Prescott, Arizona, at the age of 92.

He was born on October 10, 1932 in Cleveland, Ohio, to Edward and Mildred Jacobs (nee Platt). Richard moved to Prescott in 1944 and graduated from Prescott High School in 1950. A talented athlete and dedicated student, Richard went on to attend the University of Arizona, graduating in 1954, and was an avid lifelong University of Arizona sports fan.

Following his education, Richard served his country in the U.S. Air Force at Luke Air Force Base from 1955-1957. He later began a long and successful career, including 20 years as County Manager for TransAmerica Title Insurance Company and four years as a stock broker with Smith, Young, and Peacock. In 1982, Richard was appointed Yavapai County Treasurer, a position he held with distinction, being re-elected three times and serving until 1996.

Richard married the love of his life, Jennie R. Jacobs, on March 26, 1955. Together they shared nearly 70 wonderful years of marriage, building a legacy of love and devotion that was felt by all who knew them.

He also loved and was deeply proud of his family, always cherishing the time spent with them.

Richard is survived by his wife, Jennie Jacobs, his children Lori Hawkins and Ross Jacobs, his grandchildren, Jacob Hawkins, Paige Bryan (Steve),

Jennifer Seavey (Joshua), Ryan Jacobs (Alice), Rachel Jacobs, and Cade Jacobs, and his great-grandchildren, Haylee, Jacob, Kainan, Jaydi, Jewely, Gannon, Aubrey, Negan, Lacey, and Stevie. He is preceded in death by his beloved son Jeff Jacobs, whose memory he carried with him every day.

An avid golfer, Richards accomplishments included winning the Hassayampa Country Club Championship in 1948 as a junior in high school and becoming the first local Prescott resident to win the Smoki Golf Amateur in 1970.
