Robert H. "Bob" Foote, 78, of Prescott, AZ, passed away Saturday, December 3, 2016.

Bob was born October 18, 1938 in New Haven, CT to Edward and Dorothy (Hutchinson) Foote. He graduated from North Haven High School in 1957 and served his country in the U.S. Air Force as an Aircraft Radio Maintenance Technician. He was stationed at Davis Monthan Air Force Base in Tucson where he met his wife, Marcia, and they were married in 1962. After his honorable discharge from the Air Force, he employed the skills learned in the electronics field and began working for Philco Ford in the San Francisco area. One of Bob's proudest accomplishments was his part in developing systems that were on the LM (lunar module) which were part of the Apollo missions that took the United States to the moon. Shortly after moving with his family to Tucson in 1974, he created the R. H. Foote Excavating company, a successful career of which he devoted more than 40 years and it became a reputable excavation company in Tucson and Prescott.

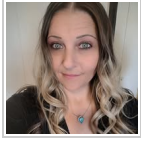
