Robert E. Sholle, Sr. passed away on Thursday, August 1, at the age of 85 years. Bob was born in Cleveland, Ohio.

In 1950, Bob was drafted for the Korean War and served 8 months on the front; although he was a good soldier, he hoped no one would ever have to go through the experience he did.

In 1959, he moved to Prescott, and owned Bob's American Service Station for a number of years. He then went to work for Connie Barrett at Flame Propane. He worked there for over 35 years as a truck driver, a service technician, a mechanic, and was known as the smiling, friendly guy at the bottle dock. Bob's wife, Thelma, preceded him in death in 2002.

He is survived by his son Robert, Jr., daughter Tara, grandsons Alec and Stephen, and his dog, Buddy. In lieu of flowers, the family suggests donations to the Yavapai Humane Society or the Arbor Day Foundation.
