Beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother and uncle died on Monday, March 16, 2015 at the age of 70. Ron was born on August 25, 1944 in Sioux City, Iowa. He was the eleventh and youngest child of Robert and Sophia Williams. He grew up on a farm outside of Sergeant Bluff, Iowa where he learned the importance of family and developed a strong work ethic that was with him until his last day. Ron enlisted in the U.S. Army and served his country for three years, first in Germany and then volunteered for a tour in Vietnam. Ron married Debbie Scanlan on November 14, 1976 in Santa Barbara. They moved to Prescott Valley, Arizona in 2006. He was an entrepreneur who opened his own print shop, Williams Printing, in Goleta. He worked there six days a week, Monday through Saturday. Preceding him in death were his parents, three brothers and three sisters.
